5. INSURANCE

By the issuance of FIM, UAM, GMAC racing license endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider or passenger is insured in accordance with the FIM requirements and must state in the FMN Start Letter that riders is in possession of the required FIM / UAM insurance.

The organizer has contracted a third party insurance in accordance with Art. 110.1 of the FIM Sporting Code and has included GMAC / Guam Racing Federation in its insurance coverage.

All entries must hold UAM license or FIM version of a CONU license & start permission letter from their Federation. (FMN)

6. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Any person or group of persons – rider, passenger, entrant, manufacturer, official, etc., recognized by the FIM/UAM and concerned by a decision taken under the authority of the FIM, may ask for redress for the consequences of that decision.

Generally, protests against the eligibility of a rider, passenger, entrant or a motorcycle entered, must be made before the start of the official practice.

Protests against results must be presented to the International Jury within 30 minutes following the announcement of the results.

All protests to the International Jury must be made in accordance with the requirement of the Disciplinary and Arbitration Code of the FIM and be accompanied by a fee of USD700.00 – or (equivalent amount in local currency) returnable if the protest is justified.

7. INTERPRETATION OF THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The interpretation of these regulations rests entirely with the Jury. In case of dispute, regarding interpretation or if there is any difference between the two official texts, the English text prevail.

10. All entrees shall submit their event participation by November 7, 2007 ; flight arrival details no later than November 23, 2007. If this info is not had then riders participation is to be personally confirmed by you with the UAM CMS with no assurance of bookings.
