HAMAGUCHI TO START ON POLE

SuperSports 600cc defending champion, Toshiyuki Hamaguchi will once again takes pole position in the opening leg of the FIM Asia Road Racing Championship 2006 at Sentul International Circuit this weekend after clocking the fastest lap time during the first Timed Practiced Session yesterday at 01:35.041s. This confirmed Hamaguchi as poleman for both Race 1 and Race 2 tomorrow.

The weather during the second Timed Practiced Session does not permit the riders to improve on their lap time. It was raining and the track was slippery during the first half of the session. However, Hamaguchi was the fastest during today's time practiced whereby he managed to clock 01:48.019s.

"I was hoping to improve on my lap time but it was raining and it is not wise to go all out. I believe the rest of the riders did not push to the maximum as well. No matter what, I am glad that yesterday I set the fastest time and will start on pole for tomorrow's race," said Hamaguchi who ride for his own team known as AG Hammer Singapore.

Three Malaysian riders will also start along with Hamaguchi on the front row based on yesterday's time practice. Abdul Rahim Sidek of Team PETRONAS Sprinta Yamaha Racing grabs the second spot on the grid (01:35.707s) while teammates Ahmad Fuad Baharudin and Ahmad Zamani Baharudin will start at third and fourth place respectively.

"I have no idea what to expect on race day. The bike set-up is not there yet and we are having some problems with the suspension. If we can make some quite changes tomorrow, I think we will be in a strong situation for tomorrow. I just hope to start the race well and finishing on the podium will be great. But for sure it will be a tough fight among the four of us, Hamaguchi, Fuad and Zamani," said Rahim.

Meanwhile, in the Underbone 115cc, Indonesian rider Gilang Pranata Sukma of Team Yamaha Pertamina Enduro 4T ART takes pole position with 02:05.691s as he sets the fastest time today. Ardhi Satya Sadarma and Feizy Judiardith took the second and third spot of the grid as both of them clocked the second and third fastest time with 02:07.937 and 02:08.492 respectively.

Mohd Hafiz Shahrudin of Team Yamaha Racing Malaysia was the best Malaysian as he will start fifth from the grid after clocking 02:10.726s. "The Indonesian riders are fast and this is my first time racing in Sentul International Circuit. I am glad today we managed to do slightly and I hope tomorrow we can fight with the Indonesian," said Hafiz.
