



VETERAN CLASS IN ASIAN MOTO CHAMPIONSHIP

FIM Asia is proud to announce that commencing at Round 1 on 15th April at Puerto Princesa, Philippines, there will be an additional category introduced into the 2012 FIM Asia Motocross/Supercross Championship (AMSC).

FIM Asia President Mr Stephan Carapiet stated that the new Class shall be for VETERANS with the following criteria:

1. Age : 40 - 55 years old
2. Documentation:
 - FIM Asia-accepted License
 - FIM Rider Insurance
 - FMN Start Permission Letter with Original Doctors' Certificate including *electrocardiogram (ECG)*
3. Motorcycles : 125/MX2
4. Races : 2 motos (race heats) of 10 minutes + 1 lap per moto

Mr. Carapiet stated he was looking forward to honouring Asian Riders who have contributed significantly to the development of motorcycle sport in the region.

“Those Riders will now have their own category within the AMSC and each Host Country can now look forward to Veterans in addition to the existing Junior 85cc and Senior 125/MX Championships at each Round” added Carapiet.
